

APPENDIX

Appendix D

GOVERNMENTAL AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS

D-1. All bonds directed to be given, shall be corporate bonds, the sureties on which shall have an office in the County and State.

D-3. Providing for the appointment of a representative of the Borough of Collingdale on a Joint Sewer Board to be created jointly with municipalities pursuant to certain acts of assembly approved April 4, 1935, and providing for the expenses of the said Board, and for the approval from time to time of the acts, recommendations, costs and expenditures of the said Board.

D-4. Approving the budget of the Darby Creek Joint Sewer Board for the year ending December 31, 1936, and making an appropriation therefor.

Authorizing the proper officers of the Borough of Collingdale to enter into a contract with the Township of Springfield, the Boroughs of Aldan, Clifton Heights, Colwyn, Darby, Lansdowne, Sharon Hill and Yeadon, and the Darby Creek Joint Authority, providing for the purchase of a site for sewage disposal plant and pumping station in the Township of Darby; the erection of a pumping station; the conveying, pumping and discharge of sewage; the operation, maintenance and repair of said

pumping station and of the Darby Creek Joint Trunk Line Sewer; the reconstruction, alteration or improvement of the said trunk line sewer and pumping station; providing for the payment of the cost thereof and for services rendered by the authority from revenues which may legally be used for such purposes and agreeing to impose sewer rentals; and making an appropriation.

Authorizing the execution of an agreement between the Townships of Haverford and Upper Darby, the Darby Creek Joint Authority, and the Townships of Springfield and Upper Darby and the Boroughs of Aldan, Clifton Heights, Collingdale, Colwyn, Darby, Lansdowne, Sharon Hill and Yeadon; providing inter alia, for the discharging of sewage by Haverford Township into the Darby Creek Trunk Line Sewer and the Darby Creek Pumping Station; the purchase of a share in the said trunk line sewer and pumping station under certain conditions; the payment of costs of operation and maintenance, the expense of administration and of the cost of a sewage disposal plant when built; the addition of 205 acres in Haverford Township to the area drained by the said sewer; the adjustment of percentages and areas as provided in an agreement of February 15, 1940; and providing for the payment of the cost of purchase, etc. and of legal and other expenses.

Authorizing an agreement between the Townships of Darby, Springfield and Upper Darby and the Boroughs of Aldan, Clifton Heights, Collingdale, Colwyn, Darby, Folcroft, Lansdowne, Sharon Hill and Yeadon and the Darby Creek Joint Authority, providing for construction of a sewage treatment plant, the construction of the Cobbs Creek Outfall Sewer, the construction of the Hermesprota Run Outfall Sewer Connection and the maintenance, operation and financing thereof; the refunding of certain existing loans to the authority; and authorizing an agreement between the said Townships and Boroughs and the said authority amending certain agreements dated February 15, 1940, and July 20, 1944.

Approving an agreement dated as of November 1, 1968 between Darby Creek Joint Authority (the "Darby Creek Authority") and the Boroughs of Aldan, Clifton Heights, Collingdale, Colwyn, Darby, Folcroft, Lansdowne, Sharon Hill and Yeadon and the Townships of Darby, Springfield and Upper Darby (the "municipalities") providing for the retention, credit and use by Darby Creek Authority of funds to be paid to it by the Radnor-Haverford-Marple Sewer Authority (the "R-H-M Authority" under an agreement dated as of September 1, 1968 between Darby Creek Authority and the R-H-M Authority (The "R-H-M Authority Agreement"); authorizing execution and delivery of said agreement; and authorizing incidental action by Borough officers.

Approving an agreement dated as of September 1, 1968 between Darby Creek Joint Authority and the Radnor-Haverford-Marple Sewer Authority providing for the acceptance, transportation, treatment and disposal by Darby Creek Joint Authority of excess sewage emanating from the Darby Creek drainage areas of the municipalities served by the Radnor-Haverford-Marple Sewer Authority; authorizing joinder therein; authorizing execution and delivery of said agreement; and authorizing incidental action by Township officers.
